

Landscape Crew Member

The Landscape Crew Member will assist in all aspects of landscape installation projects with supervision and support from the Foreman. The Landscape Crew Member is accountable to the Foreman and Lead Foreman. It is vital that the Landscape Crew Member share and uphold Phillips Garden's core values.

Job Duties:

- Assist in all job-related tasks of building a landscape including initial layout, demo, hardscape, bed prep, and planting.
- Operate various tools and equipment, including: measurement equipment, transits (zip levels), compactors, shovels, hammers, drills, grinders, saws, etc.
- Assist in the construction of hardscape elements (walkways, patios, walls, etc) using best practices.
- Assist with light carpentry elements (setting posts, trellis, pergolas, fences, screens, etc).
- Perform land clearing activities, dig ditches or trenches.
- Amend garden beds and plant trees, shrubs, and perennials using best horticultural practices.
- Transport materials using shovels, wheelbarrows, carts, dollies, and hand lifting/carrying
- Perform preventative maintenance on tools and equipment by conducting inspections, lubricating, and cleaning on a daily basis.
- Load and unload materials, tools, and equipment required to complete landscape construction projects.
- Drive and operate company vehicles safely to and from job sites and material vendors.
- Maintain a clean and orderly job site.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment at all times or as equipment or tools specify.
- On the job training for all aspects of our landscape projects and processes.
- Clear and positive communication with clients, other crew members, foreman and landscape designers.
- · Comply with all company policies and regulations and uphold company Core Values
- Other duties as assigned

- · Valid driver's license and safe driving record.
- Effective communication skills (both verbal and written)
- · Lift a minimum of 60 lbs. repeatedly through an entire work shift
- Time management skills

- Ability to be trained on materials, methods, tools, and equipment required to complete various landscape/construction practices
 including: walls, patios, walkways (stone and precast), soil prep and planting
- Work both independently with little supervision, and as part of a team
- Walk, stand, crouch for long periods of time and carry out strenuous physical tasks
- Work with hand tools, power tools, small engine equipment, and materials
- Capable of learning how to operate required equipment and tools in a safe and responsible manner
- Work in a fast-paced environment
- Good manual dexterity
- Excellent stamina is required
- Work near heavy equipment and other vehicles on a regular basis
- Work outdoors in various conditions including heat and humidity, rain, dust, noise, and cold
